



Preschoolers with Speech Impairments Needed for Research Study

WHO: Children ages 3 & 4 who understand what is said to them, but may have difficulty being understood by some people.

WHAT: Participants will use iPads with communication apps to learn new sentence building skills. Parents will receive training, and some participants will receive biweekly language therapy. No prior communication app experience is required.
