Athletic trainers are healthcare providers who offer services in injury and illness prevention, emergency care, clinical diagnostics, therapeutic intervention and rehabilitation.

They work in a wide variety of settings, including secondary schools, college and universities, professional sports organizations, performing arts facilities, outpatient clinics, hospitals, and industries.



Employment of athletic trainers is projected to grow 23 percent from 2016 to 2026, much faster than the average for all occupations.
